Troupe Reminder

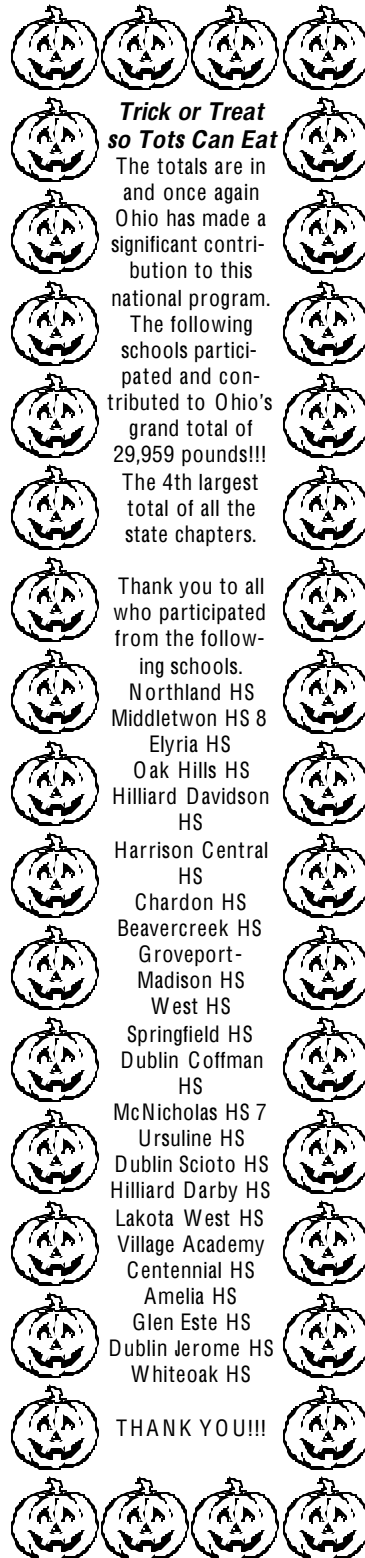
